

What you need to know for this year's skiing season!!!

- Ski Club is open to any St. Mary **Middle School** student beginner to advanced.
- SKI PACKETS are available online and Student Ski/Snowboard Club ID/Discount Cards will be available in the school office.
- Ski dates for Alpine Valley are Dec. 15, Jan. 5, Jan. 19, Jan. 26. You must go on <u>at least one Alpine Valley trip</u> to attend the All-Day trip on Friday, February 9. You are <u>NOT</u> required to go on all outings! If you plan to snowboard on the All-Day trip you must <u>snowboard on at least two Alpine Valley trips</u>, NO <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>. The All-Day trip will be from approximately 9:00 a.m. to approximately 2:00 p.m.



Alpine Valley Rental forms must be completed electronically only one time by a parent/guardian if your student is renting any of the following equipment: ski/snowboard and/or helmet. The rental link is available on the Waukesha Catholic website. If you do not complete the online rental process your student will not have equipment to participate in the scheduled ski event. This is the only way to rent equipment this year. Note: The rental form you will be filling out is a legal binding document for your Alpine visit.

Food may NOT be carried into Alpine Valley. A food pass is available for purchase for \$15.00*. The pass includes Main Item Choice: Hot Dog, Corn Dog, Cheeseburger, Hamburger, Pizza slice, Chicken or Cold Sandwich/Wrap (Ham or Turkey) Choice of Side: Fries or whole fruit Banana/Apple and 1 fountain drink or milk. This will save about \$3.00 if the above items were purchased individually.

The pass is a safer alternative to sending cash with your student.

- Cost: Alpine Valley lift ticket and bus \$45.00
 Alpine Valley lift ticket, helmet, and bus \$60.00
 Alpine Valley lift ticket, rental, helmet, and bus \$90.00
 *Add \$15.00 to the total if you purchase a food pass.
 Alpine Valley trips will be on Fridays from 4:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- One chaperone is needed for every ten students. See SKI PACKET for more info.
- Chaperones are required to have current Safeguarding on file as well as complete the Driver's Safety as well as have current driver's license and insurance information on file. No exceptions will be made. See chaperone form for more information.

Permission slips for Alpine Valley must be filled out for **each** trip. All the permission slips are available **online at www.waukeshacatholic.org.** Click on *About Us* and then *Extracurricular*.

Permission slips are due in the school office listed on the permission slip <u>BEFORE NOON</u>! NO LATE SLIPS WILL BE ACCEPTED!
