Urgent Help Needed at The Seton Volleyball Championships!

The Elizabeth Seton Volleyball Championships needs your help! *Waukesha Catholic hosts the tournament and is one of the 3 organizations that benefits financially from it* (in addition to Waukesha County Catholic School Tuition Assistance and the Foundation for Retired Religious), with the tournament serving as <u>our single-largest athletic</u>



<u>fundraiser each year</u>, raising approximately 1/4 of our annual athletic budget. This allows us to keep our athletic participation fees down and helps fund our programs in many ways.

The Seton volleyball championships is still in need of volunteers, both adult and middle schoolers, to cover several areas of the tournament the week of November 1st-7th. The tournament is the 8th grade Archdiocesan championships, with up to 84 teams playing 116 matches over 7 days. Both our 8th grade boys and 8th grade girls teams will be participating in the tournament this year! The weekday matches will be played at the Milwaukee Sting Center in Menomonee Falls, with the weekend Final Four being played at Catholic Memorial HS (CMH). 2 years ago we estimated over 150 volunteers gave more than 1300 volunteer hours to help run the tournament, including all of the planning & preparation, as well as helping during the tournament week. Please help if you are able so that our Seton committee and athletic board members can supervise crowd control and address other issues as they arise.

We need help in the following areas:

Middle schoolers to flip score & ipad scoring (sit at the scoring table with a high school or adult scorekeeper and mark points on the flip-scoreboards & ipad for online viewers). We traditionally would have 7th graders do this to help the 8th graders playing and so they know what to expect when they get to 8th grade and get to play in The Seton.
