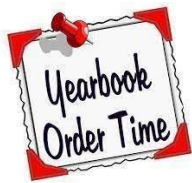
Congrats to the Stover family!

Medical Absences

Please remember to get a note from the doctor's office/urgent care when your child has a visit. Send that note to the school office to update your child's attendance to reflect the medical absence.

Dress for the Weather

Be sure that your child(ren) dress for the weather. Students will go outside for recess unless the "feels like" temperature is below zero. Snow pants and boots are required for students to be off the sidewalk this time of year. Please label their outerwear. This makes finding forgotten items easier to return.

Medications

If your child needs medications while at school, you will need to turn in the appropriate medication form. There are two forms which can always be found on the Waukesha Catholic website under the Parent Information tab and then Forms. One form is for Prescription Medication which needs to be signed by your child's Medical Provider. You may want to print a copy of this form and take it to the doctor's office with you in the case that medication during the school day is requested. The other form is for any non-prescription medication that you would like your child to have while at school. All medications must come to the school office and be in the original container.
