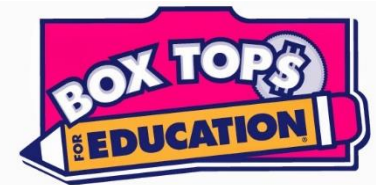
Congrats to the Bailey family!

Medications

If your child needs medications while at school, you will need to turn in the appropriate medication form. There are two forms which can always be found on the Waukesha Catholic website under the Parent Information tab and then Forms. One form is for Prescription Medication which needs to be signed by your child's Medical Provider. You may want to print a copy of this form and take it to the doctor's office with you in the case medication during the school day is requested. The other form is for any non-prescription medication that you would like your child to have while at school. All medications must come to the school office and be in the original container.
