Spring MAPs Testing

During the weeks of May 8 – May 26, students in grades 1 through 8 will take tests called Measures of Academic Progress[™] (MAP). We give our students MAP tests two times each school year to determine a child's instructional level, to assist teachers in differentiating instruction, and to measure academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Reading, Language Arts and Math. Students will take the tests on a Chromebook.

MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for each child's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. In addition, with MAP tests, we can administer shorter tests and use less class time while still receiving detailed, accurate information about students' growth. During the next testing period, students will spend a total of about 2-2.5 hours completing these tests.
